Appointment of Officer

On March 16, 2022, the board of directors of Nuveen Global Cities REIT, Inc. (the “Company”) appointed Richard M. Kimble to serve as Co-President of the Company, effective immediately. Mr. Kimble had previously served as the Company’s Head of Portfolio Management since July 2017. The appointment of Mr. Kimble was not made pursuant to any arrangement or understanding between him or any other person. Biographical information with respect to Mr. Kimble is set forth below.

Mr. Kimble has served as the Company’s Co-President since March 2022 and previously served as the Company’s Head of Portfolio Management from July 2017 to March 2022. Mr. Kimble has over 18 years of experience in structuring and managing equity and debt components of commercial real estate. Prior to serving as Head of Portfolio Management for the Company, Mr. Kimble held numerous roles on Nuveen Real Estate’s transactions and portfolio management teams and has been involved in more than \$8 billion of transactions. In 2012, he opened Nuveen Real Estate’s San Francisco office and built out the Northwest transaction team. Before joining the firm in 2007, he worked for RER Financial Group and specialized in CMBS due diligence assignments, acquisitions, and debt restructurings. Mr. Kimble holds a B.S. in Economics from Mary Washington College and an M.B.A. from the University of North Carolina, Chapel Hill. In addition, he is a CFA Charterholder and is a member of the Urban Land Institute and Commercial Real Estate Development Association.

In connection with Mr. Kimble’s previous appointment as Head of Portfolio Management, the Company entered into an indemnification agreement with Mr. Kimble, which remains in effect.

Resignation of Officer

On March 16, 2022, Timothy S.G. Horrocks resigned from his position as Co-President, Head of European Investment of the Company. Mr. Horrocks’s resignation is not due to any disagreement with the Company on any matter relating to the Company’s operations, policies or practices.
